2. Computerized (OMR) examination cum application form. The candidate must ensure his/her eligibility before filling in the form.
3. Bona fide resident of Rajasthan but studying in other state can also apply.
4. Certificate for physically handicapped (PH) candidates from Medical Board constituted by State Government only.
5. Intimation for counselling through Notice Boards of the RUHS and advertisement in State level **newspapers**.
6. Registration No. of applications received in the University will be made available on the Website of the University www.ruhsraj.org from **May 17, 2010**.
7. Roll number and Centre allocated to each candidate will be made available on the Website of the University www.ruhsraj.org after **May 20, 2010**.
8. Answer sheets shall be OMR type in duplicate and answers on OMR sheet to be marked by **black ballpoint pen only**. **Candidates will be allowed to take the second copy of answer sheet.**
9. To prevent impersonation thumb impression shall also be registered on a biometric machine during the conduct of examination, which shall be verified at the time of counselling.
10. Videography of the examination processes and photography of each candidate will also be done during both Papers at the Examination Centre.
11. Moderated Standard Answer key shall be published in State level newspapers and on the website of RUHS.
12. **Cost of the form (Rs. 1000/-) non-refundable**, includes the application and examination fee.
13. Form will be sold through branches of the Oriental Bank of Commerce from 5th March 2010.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING FOR RPMT –2010

1. The Application set is in four parts: (A) The "Admission Form", for admission to MBBS/BDS/ B.V.Sc. & A.H. in the State of Rajasthan; (B) The "OMR Examination cum Application Form"; (C) Two window envelopes for dispatching **the admission card and mark-sheet** and (D) the large envelope for sending the filled in form to this office. **All these are supplied in another large envelope.**
2. A Guide Book named "**Information Booklet**" containing rules and procedure etc. and a **Syllabus** containing model questions and model answer sheets are also supplied. **Both these should be retained by the candidates.**
3. The candidate should fill in all the entries on form 'A' in his/her own **handwriting using capital letters only** and form 'B' should be filled as per instructions given on page 6 of the information Booklet to fill the OMR sheet. **The candidate must paste a postal stamp of Rs. 5/- each at the place indicated on each envelope.**
4. If there is any difference in data of Form A & Form B, then for the examination purpose, data in Form B will be considered final and the candidate will be responsible for the same.
5. The candidate shall send filled forms 'A' and 'B' and all envelopes to the Convener RPMT-2010, Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Sector-18, Kumbha Marg, Pratap Nagar, Tonk Road, Jaipur – 302 033 (Raj.)
6. The form should be sent either by Registered Post/ Speed Post or it may be submitted in person in the office of the Convener RPMT-2010.
7. **The Application Form must reach this office latest by 5th April 2010 up to 5:00 P.M.** Application forms, for whatsoever reasons, reaching after this time and date shall not be entertained. No excuse for delay in submission of application form shall be accepted.
8. RUHS, Jaipur will not be responsible for any postal delay. Candidates are advised to send the forms well in advance considering the postal delays and time taken by postal authorities for delivery of speed post.
9. Incomplete application forms / incomplete attested enclosures with the application form will not be considered.
10. The RUHS shall not be accountable for any application form handed over personally at any place other than the RPMT–2010 office at RUHS, Kumbha Marg, Pratap Nagar, Jaipur.
11. The candidate must put his/her recent coloured photographs on form 'A' & 'B'. The photograph must be taken on or after 01-01-2010 alongwith the name of the candidate and date of taking the photograph. Photograph should not have cap or goggles. Two photographs with name of the candidate and his/her form number on the back of the photographs should also be enclosed. **All photographs should be identical.** Candidates are advised to obtain about two-dozen copies of the photograph, as the identical photographs would be required at the time of counselling/ admission. Wherever an attested photograph is needed (as mentioned in the form), it should be duly attested by an Executive Magistrate/Gazetted Officer or by the Principal/Director of University College/the Principal of the School last attended by the candidate.
12. The Certificate No. 1 printed in the Admission Form 'A' must be signed by the Parent/Guardian of the candidate. A person can be a guardian of a candidate only if candidate's parents are not alive or are insane. The certificate No. 2 printed in the Admission Form 'A' must be signed by the Principal/Head of Institution last attended by the candidate with official seal.

13. The candidate must ensure his/her eligibility before filling in the form. The criteria for eligibility are given in this booklet. The candidate must submit a proper eligibility certificate printed in the form (A) under the heading "Certificate No. 3" in support of his/her eligibility. **In the absence of such a certificate, the application form shall be rejected. The cost application cum examination form shall not be refunded in any case; therefore, candidate should ensure his/her eligibility before filling the form.**
14. Each candidate must clearly mention the category of reservation desired by him/her. A candidate should mention only one category. This office shall mark category on the admission card of the candidate. On receiving the admission card the candidate should immediately check the category carefully and in case of any discrepancy, the candidate shall immediately have to intimate the details to this office for correction. No change of category will be permitted after conduct of examination.
15. The candidate of any category out of Gen./ST/Scheduled Area/SC/OBC, if any, applying for additional reservation as Physically Handicapped or ward of Defence Personnel, or ward of Para-military personnel should mention this information on space provided at **page 1 of Form 'A' and also at S. No. 7 in Form 'B'**.
16. For "Physically Handicapped" (PH) category, read details as mentioned in reservation criteria (h) at page 14.
17. The student presently studying and appearing at Senior Secondary Examination, 2010 can also apply for RPMT-2010. Such candidates shall be permitted provisionally to appear at RPMT-2010. They must submit their mark-sheet to the convener, U.G. Admission Board at the time of counselling. No fee is required for submission of such a mark-sheet and in case of selection for admission to the MBBS/ BDS Course, he/ she shall not be admitted in that course until he/ she fulfills the eligibility criteria.

18. Enclosures: -

Following documents must be attached with the form: -

- I. True copies of the Mark-sheets of passing the Secondary and Senior Secondary School examinations and of the higher examination, if any, duly attested.
- II. Attested Photocopy of Secondary School Examination Certificate in support of the Date of Birth.
- III. A certificate for eligibility under Clause 3 (C) printed in Information Booklet and Form "A" Various certificates for different conditions of eligibility are printed in the form (A) under the heading " Certificate No. 3 ". **Any one certificate out of these must be filled in, got signed by Competent Authority before submitting the form. No replacement of any of these certificates shall be accepted.**
- IV. In proof of the desired reservation category, the Certificate should be attached for the Caste/Tribe of the candidate issued by a Competent Authority appointed by Government of Rajasthan to enable the candidate to be placed in the Reservation Category like SC/ST/Scheduled Area/OBC, as the case may be. **The reservation category desired by the candidate should be clearly mentioned in forms (A) and (B). At both these places, same category should be mentioned.** A candidate can apply for only one type of category as given in the Information Booklet. However, he/she must give additional information at proper places provided in the form 'A' and 'B', whether he/she is applying as PH/DP/PM candidate. (PH-Physically Handicapped, DP-Defence Personnel, PM-Para Military Personnel.)
- V. The candidates desirous of seeking reservation under the category of 'Defence Personnel' or 'Para Military Personnel' must enclose a relevant certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The reservation under any of these categories shall not be considered in absence of proper certificate. The candidates applying under '**Defence Personnel' category must ensure that their priority is also clearly mentioned in the Certificate.** The Performa's for Certificates under these categories are printed in Information Booklet.

- VI. The candidates desirous of seeking reservation under the category of 'Physically Handicapped' must submit **the proper certificate issued by a Medical Board constituted by Central/State Government and Percentage disability should be clearly mentioned on it.**
- VII. Two coloured photographs with name of the candidate and his/her form number on the back of the photographs.

18. **Incomplete forms: -**

The form shall be treated incomplete, if-

- I. Any column of the application form is left blank.
- II. The properly attested photograph is not pasted on form 'A';
- III. Certificate No. 1 to 3 printed in the form 'A', are not properly signed by Competent Authority and official seal is not clearly legible on it;
- IV. The photo copies of the Marks sheet(s) of class X and XII and Higher Examinations if any, are not enclosed;
- V. The necessary certificates for deciding the category of reservation is not submitted;
- VI. The necessary document in support of the date of birth is not enclosed. This is required separately if the date of birth is not entered in the mark sheet of class X.
- VII. Two coloured photographs with name of the candidate and his/her form number on the back of the photographs are not enclosed.

Important: –

1. "It is essential that all coloured photographs should be exactly identical (that is, made out of one negative) and one of them (which is pasted on form A) must be signed by the candidate and be attested by a Competent Authority. If this condition is not observed, the form shall be rejected".
 2. The form shall also be treated incomplete if all the columns meant to be filled in by the candidates are not filled or are not marked "Not Applicable", as the case may be. The form shall also be treated incomplete if any part of it has been removed. The complete form (A) and (B) as supplied must be returned after filling in all columns. The forms incomplete in any manner as explained above shall be rejected.
19. The jurisdiction for legal cases arising out of RPMT-2010 shall be limited to the Courts in Jaipur Bench of Rajasthan High Court only.

 21. Every candidate shall be allotted a registration number. He/She can find his/her registration number on the website www.ruhsraj.org from 17th May, 2010 onwards. The number should be quoted in all subsequent correspondence.

**INSTRUCTION TO FILL UP OMR EXAMINATION CUM APPLICATION FORM
(FORM -'B') FOR RPMT-2010**

The processing of application sheet is based on OMR scanning. So, you are advised to completely and carefully follow the instructions given below. **Please, be careful in filling the OMR application form and darkening the ovals. To avoid error, it is advised that candidate should practice on Photocopy of blank OMR application form. Information in OMR should match to the information you provide in the FORM 'A' and the document you submit. Any error committed intentional or otherwise may result in cancellation of your candidature.**

- A. Use only black ballpoint pen to write in box.
- B. Use HB pencil to darken the oval.
- C. In the box write with black ballpoint pen using capital letters or numerical and darken the corresponding oval located below/in front of as the case may be with HB pencil.
- D. Do not make any stray marks on this sheet.
- E. Do not staple, pin, wrinkle, scribble, tear, wet or fold this sheet.
- F. Paste your coloured photograph at the space provided. Do not pin it up.
- G. When you complete the sheet, fold it at the place marked for it and put the sheet inside the envelope straight. No other fold should be done.
- H. Method to darken the oval correctly.

Box No 1- Date of Birth: First write your date of birth in the boxes in the form of DD MM YY and then darken the ovals given below by HB Pencil.

Box No 2- Status of Class XII Exam: - First write in the space provide PASSED/ APPEARING and then blacken the appropriate oval.

Box No 3- If you have already passed the Class XII Exam: - Fill the year of passing the exam.

Box No 4- Category: Write one of the categories mentioned in the boxes as applicable to you and fill the corresponding oval in front of the category mentioned.

BoxNo 5- Name of candidate: Write in capital letters in the boxes provided and then darken the corresponding oval given below by HB Pencil.

Box No. 6- Write MALE/FEMALE in box and darken the appropriate oval.

- Box No. 7-** Additional Category: If you are physically handicapped (PH) or ward of Defence personnel (DP) or ward of Para military (PM) personnel, write the appropriate category in the box and darken the corresponding oval in form of the category.
- Box No. 8-** Eligibility certificate filled for rule 3 (C) in form "A" Here you have to mention the rule under which you have filled eligibility certificate in FORM 'A' and darken the appropriate oval below the rule indicated.
- Box No. 9-(1-3)** Marks obtained in individual papers and Max. Marks. Write in the box the marks secured by you in Sr. Sec. Examination in the papers of Physics, Chemistry and Biology and the maximum marks of these papers and darken the appropriate ovals.
- Box No.9(4)-** You should provide the total marks of Physics, Chemistry and Biology along with the maximum marks of these three papers.
- Box No. 9(5)-** Provide the percentage of the total of Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
- Box No.9-(6)** Marks obtained in English and Max. Marks. Write in the box the marks secured by you in Sr. Sec. Examination in English and the maximum marks and darken the appropriate ovals.
- Box No. 10-** Choice of the centre city: Here you should give three choices for the centre in order of preference, where you want to take your examination from the twelve cities given.
- I preference:** - Here you should write your first choice of examination centre of the city and darken the appropriate oval on the same row. Please darken only one oval in the row.
- II preference:** - Here you should write your second choice of examination centre of the city and darken the appropriate oval on the same row. Please darken only one oval in the row.
- III preference:** - Here you should write your third choice of examination centre of the city and darken the appropriate oval on the same row. Please darken only one oval in the row.
- Box No.11-** Here you should write the full address along with phone/Mobile number (with STD code), where the communication to you could be made. Paste your unattested colour photograph and put your signature in the appropriate box. Write the application form no. on the back of the photo before pasting it.
- Box No.12-** Father's Name: Write in capital letters in the boxes provided and then darken the corresponding oval given below.
- Box No. 13-** Mother's Name: Write in capital letters in the boxes provided and then darken the corresponding oval given below.
- Box No. 14-** Write the medium of question paper and darken corresponding oval.
- Box No. 15-** Order of Preference for Courses: Here you should write the order no. of preference for the courses (M.B.B.S./B.DS./B.V.Sc. & A H.) and then darken the corresponding oval given below.
- Box No. 16-** Phone Number with STD code: Write your contact no. prefixing STD code.
- Box No. 17-** Mobile Number: Write your mobile number.
- Box No. 18-** Declaration: Write your name and sign the declaration with date.
- Box No. 19 & 20-** The left Thumb and Index Finger prints must be affixed by the applicant in front of the officer attesting / endorsing his/her form. Failure to comply to this instruction / sending the filled-in application form without the Thumb and Index Finger prints will lead to immediate rejection of the application for the Entrance Examination.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE EXAMINATION

1. The examination for RPMT-2010 shall be held at the centres located in the following cities: Ajmer, Bharatpur, Bikaner, Jaipur, Jodhpur, Kota and Udaipur. All candidates are required to appear at entrance examination at their own expenses.
2. The choice of three centres, in order of preference, should be clearly mentioned in the form "B". **However, the University reserves the right to create a new centre or to cancel/ change the above centres and allocate any centre to the candidate as per policy decided in this regard. The decision of the University shall be final in this regard.**
3. **The centres once allotted shall not be changed in any case.**
4. The examinations shall be held as per programme given below on **Sunday, 6th June 2010:**

5. Each question paper shall be of 300 marks and shall contain 100 objective type questions. Each question shall have four options to answer. The candidate should blacken only one circle with black ballpoint pen corresponding to the correct answer. Three (+3) marks shall be awarded for each correct answer and minus one (-1) mark for a wrong answer and '0' for un-attempted questions. All circles will be empty in the OMR answer sheets supplied in the examination hall. No change in the answer once marked is allowed. **If more than one circles are found blackened for the answer of one question, it will be deemed as incorrect answer and shall be negatively marked ("-1" mark shall be awarded for such incorrect answer).**
6. The Examination Hall will be opened 30 minutes before commencement of the examination. Candidates are expected to report at above specified reporting time. A seat with a roll number will be allotted to each candidate. Candidates must find out and occupy and take their allotted seat immediately. If the candidates do not report in time and take their seats immediately after reporting they are likely to miss some of general instructions to be announced in the examination hall.
7. No candidate coming after 15 minutes from the commencement of examination will be permitted to sit in the examination. It may be noted that the gates of the Examination Centre will be closed at sharp 8.15 AM for Paper I and at sharp 1.15 PM for Paper II.
8. If a candidate is found appearing in the test from the seat or room other than the one allotted to him/her, his/her candidature will be cancelled.
9. Candidate will be required to produce admission card before he/she is allowed to enter the examination Centre.
10. **Under any circumstance the Centre Superintendent shall not admit any candidate to the examination hall in absence of his/her admission card issued by the University.**
11. Candidates are not allowed to carry any textual material, written or printed, bits of paper, photocopy of admission card, envelope or any other material except the original admit card inside the examination hall. Cellular/mobile phone/calculator/slide rules/ log tables/ laptop/palmtop or any other electronic gadgets etc. are strictly prohibited in the examination hall. Candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any of the banned items to the venue of the examination, as arrangement for safekeeping cannot be assured.
12. A bell will be rung at the beginning of the examination and at the closing time. The candidate must stop marking the responses/writing the answer.

13. The candidate must sign at the appropriate place in the Attendance Sheet and must mark impressions of the left Thumb and Index Finger of left hand in the appropriate column of the Attendance Sheet. Failure to comply with this requirement will lead to the annulling of his candidature without any prior intimation.
14. No candidate shall be allowed to go outside the Examination Hall/ Centre till completion of the examination in each session. Candidates should not leave the Examination Hall without handing over their Answer Sheets to the invigilator on duty.
15. The candidate shall maintain silence and attend to their paper only. Any disturbance by the candidate at the examination will be deemed misbehavior and the candidate involved in such activity shall forfeit his/her right to continue in the examination. The decision of the Centre superintendent shall be final and conclusive in the matter.
16. The University shall arrange for vedigraphy/ photography of individual candidate. The candidates are required to keep their head in upright position and face the camera during this process so that their identity can be clearly established.
17. To prevent impersonation Right thumb impression shall be registered at the examination centre during conduct of Paper I on a biometric machine. In case due to injury or some other reason, Right thumb impression could not be registered on the machine, Left thumb impression or in case it is also injured or for any other reason, it could not be registered on the machine, impression of any finger shall be registered on the machine.
18. During conduct of Paper II and also during the counselling, genuineness of the candidate will be established by verification/ authentication of the earlier impression registered on the biometric machine.
19. In order to ensure proper registration of thumb impression at the examination centre on biometric machine, candidates should ensure that there should not be any mark of 'mehndi' or dye or any other material on their hands as this may hinder the registration of thumb impression on the biometric machine.
20. If for any reason during the conduct of Paper II, the biometric machine does not authenticate the earlier registered impression of the candidate, which might be possible due to technical reasons like excessive rubbing of hands for removing stamp ink etc., two impressions, one of Left thumb and the other of Index Finger of the Right Hand of the candidate shall be registered and the candidate will be allowed to sit in Paper II examination. However, the Centre Superintendent and the Observer appointed by the University shall have to report the details of such cases alongwith Roll Number and Name of the concerned candidates whose registered impression are not authenticated on biometric machine during Paper II examination. Genuineness of such candidates shall have to be carefully ensured at the time of counselling.
21. The candidate shall be allowed to participate in the counselling only when the impression of candidate registered at the examination centre during conduct of Paper I and also at least one impression of candidate registered during conduct of Paper II matches at the time of counselling.
22. If impressions registered on the biometric machine do not match as above then the case shall be referred to the finger print experts alongwith all details and original thumb/ finger impressions taken on the attendance sheets at the examination centre, application form and sample impressions obtained from the candidate at the time of counselling. If genuineness of the candidate is not established from the report of finger print experts then the case shall be dealt under the provisions of unfairmeans and case of criminal offence shall be registered against the candidate and other concerned persons.
23. No candidate shall use unfairmeans or indulge in disorderly conduct at or in connection with the examinations. Unfairmeans shall include the following: -
 - i) Making a false representation pertaining to the eligibility of the candidate to appear in the examination;
 - ii) Communicating or attempting to communicate with the Convenor or Registrar of the University or any person of his office or any person connected with the conduct of examination with the object of finding out the name and address of the paper-setter or examiner, or with any paper-setter or examiner, or unduly influencing any person connected with the conduct of examinations; Any attempt on the part of the candidate to influence directly or indirectly the admission procedures will be viewed seriously;

- iii) Talking to another candidate or any unauthorized person inside or outside the examination room during the examination hours without the permission of a member of the supervisory staff, before handing over the answer-book to the invigilator;
- iv) Giving or receiving assistance in answering the question paper to or from any other candidate/person in the examination hall or outside during the examination hours;
- v) During examination time having in possession or access to:
 - a) Any paper, book, note or any other unauthorized material, which has relevance to the syllabus of the examination paper concerned;
 - b) Anything written on the inkpot cover, inkpot, scale, or any other instrument or any kind of furniture or any other substance, which may have relevance to the syllabus of the examination paper concerned;
 - c) Anything written or signs made on the body of the candidate on his clothes/ garments, hand-kerchief etc. which may have relevance to the syllabus of examination paper concerned;
 - d) Anything written, or signs made on the admission card/ bits of paper/ question paper which have relevance to the syllabus of the examination paper concerned;
- vi) Swallowing or attempting to swallow, or destroying or attempting to destroy a note or paper or any other material, or running away with the material with the intention of destroying the evidence of using unfair means, or being guilty of causing disappearance or destruction of any such material either by himself or with the assistance of any other person;
- vii) Smuggling a question paper or part thereof or an answer-book/ OMR Answer sheet into the examination room/centre or out of it;
- viii) Replacing or getting replaced an OMR answer sheet during or after the examination;
- ix) Impersonating any candidate or getting impersonated by any person for taking the examination;
- x) Copying of a part of question Booklet/ test Booklet; Writing anything (even the questions, in part or in totality) on the admission card/carbon copy of the OMR Answer sheet or any other Paper;
- xi) Tampering with records of an examination;
- xii) Using any obscene or abusive language in his answer-book;
- xiii) Cheating or attempting to cheat the University in any manner and
- xiv) any act or omission, by or on behalf of the candidate connected with the examination, whether prior to or subsequent to such examination or the result thereof, which in the opinion of the Board of Management, is Unfair means.

b.) Disorderly Conduct: -

1. The candidate in the examination hall or outside but within the campus of the Examination Centre during the examination shall be under the disciplinary control of the Superintendent of the Centre or his nominee and shall obey his instructions.
2. **Disorderly conduct includes:**
 - i) Disobeying the instructions of the Superintendent/ Addl. Superintendent /Asstt. Superintendent/ Invigilator or Observer or any member of the Flying Squad or any other member of staff working at the examination centre.
 - ii) Threatening, intimidating or assaulting the Superintendent, Invigilator, any member of the Flying Squad or Observer or any other member of staff working at the examination centre, or another candidate in connection with the examination before, during or after the examination hours.
 - iii) Misbehaving with the Superintendent, Invigilator or any member of the Flying Squad or Observer or any other member working at the examination centre in connection with the examination before, during or after the examination hours;

- iv) Leaving the examination room before the completion of examination and/or without handing over the answer-book to the Invigilator or without signing the attendance sheet;
- v) Tearing off or mutilating an answer-book/ OMR sheet or any part thereof;
- vi) Disturbing or disrupting the conduct of examination or attempting to do so;
- vii) Inciting or compelling any other candidate to leave the examination room or to disturb/disrupt/boycott the examination;
- viii) Bringing into the Examination Hall/Centre (a) any weapon or (b) any other material objected to by the Invigilator/Centre Superintendent or any other member of the Supervisory Staff;
- ix) Appearing in the examination without being in possession of the Admission Card issued by the University for the said examination;
- x) Refusing to be searched by the Invigilator/Centre Superintendent/any other member of the Supervisory Staff/any member of the Flying Squad, or obstructing or hindering such search in the Examination Hall, Verandah, Urinal, etc.

3. Punishment:

A candidate found guilty of unfair means or disorderly conduct at or in connection with an examination, shall at the discretion of the Board of Management, be punished with one or more of the following: -

- i) Cancellation of the examination in respect of which he is found to have been guilty;
 - ii) Debarring the candidate from appearing at any future examination of the University permanently in future or for a stated period;
 - iii) In addition to above i) and ii) the candidate shall also be liable for criminal action;
 - iv) Any other punishment deemed suitable by the Board of Management.
24. The OMR answer sheet in duplicate shall be having four empty circles for each questions, in order of answers a, b, c or d. To answer a question, **the candidate should fill in the appropriate circle/oval with a black ballpoint pen only.**
 25. The candidate must ensure that both the invigilators present in the examination hall have put their signatures on the first OMR answer sheet in such a way that clear impression are made on all other sheets. The candidates must also ensure that they had marked their signatures and both thumb impressions (left & right) in the space provided on the OMR Answer Sheet. No part of the Question Booklet should be removed from it. At the end of each exam, the question booklet and the first and second copy of answer sheets must be handed over to the Invigilator before leaving the examination room.
 26. **The candidate will not be allowed to take the Question Booklet under any circumstances. The candidates will however be allowed to take away the second copy of answer sheet with him at the end of each examination.**
 27. **Question Booklet will not be provided to any candidate in any case even after completion of the admission process and this shall remain exclusive property of the university.**
 28. The candidates securing equal marks shall be placed in one rank. Their merit within one rank shall be decided at the time of counselling on the basis of higher marks secured in 10+2 examination.
 29. The mark sheets shall be sent by post at the address given by the candidates.
 30. **The standard answer keys provided by the papers setter shall be moderated by an expert committee to be appointed by the RUHS after the conduct of RPMT–2010. This moderated standard answer key shall be published in the newspapers after the declaration of result. There will not be any change in answer key after declaration of result.**
 31. In case of wrong and/or multiple correct answers to a question, the Committee of experts will take appropriate decision for award of marks.

32. The reassessment can be applied for within 10 days from the publication of answer key. No excuse for delay in this matter shall be entertained. The application for reassessment should be addressed to The Convener RPMT-2010.
33. The reassessment fee is Rs. 200/-per paper, which should be essentially enclosed with the application. The fee must be paid in the form of cash /bank draft only payable to The Convener RPMT-2010 and payable at Jaipur. The reassessment of answer sheets and question paper booklets of candidates shall be preserved only for 3 months from the date of publication of RPMT-2010, merit list.
34. Any change of address for sending the admission card or the mark sheet should be immediately informed.
35. If necessary, a duplicate mark sheet can be applied for with a Bank draft of Rs. 500/- in favour of the Convener RPMT-2010, payable at any Bank in Jaipur or by depositing in cash.
36. The admission forms of successful candidates shall be preserved for twelve months from the last date of applying for reassessment.

I. NAME OF THE INSTITUTIONS:

List of Government and Private colleges may be seen on the website www.ruhsraj.org.

Note: -Admission in all Private Medical and Dental Colleges will be allowed only after the permission of MCI/ DCI, New Delhi for the Academic Session 2010-11.

NUMBER OF SEATS:

The total number of seats in Government/ Private Medical/Dental Colleges will be finalized before and published in local newspapers. **In case of any further change it shall be notified at the time of counselling.**

II RESERVATION:

- (a) 15% of the seats in Govt. Colleges will be reserved in MBBS/BDS Course to be filled up by an All India Entrance Examination to be conducted by the agency of Govt. of India.
- (b) Out of total 24 Seats, 4 in each State Medical College of Rajasthan of MBBS Course will be reserved for candidates selected under the Central Government pool. The Central Government Authority will fill up these seats.

Note: - The remaining seats shall be treated as the State Seats and will be filled up on merit cum- preference in State Pre-Medical Test with following reservations: -

- (c) 16% seats, after excluding the seats of sub- clause (a) (b) above are reserved for natural born (not adopted) candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-III. 25% out of the above reserved seats shall be reserved for girl candidates belonging to Schedule Caste.
- (d)
 - (i) 12% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clauses (a) (b) above are reserved for natural born (not adopted) candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-III. 25% out of the above reserved seats will be reserved for girl candidates belonging to Schedule Tribe. 45% of ST seats are to be for ST candidates who are bona fide residents of scheduled area (tribal area).
 - (ii) 21% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clauses (a), (b) above are reserved for those belonging to Other Backward Classes as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-III. 25%, out of the above reserved seats shall be reserved for girl candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes.
- (e) Six seats for MBBS and one seat for BDS out of the qualified candidates in the RPMT–2010 shall be reserved on priority cum merit for the natural born (not adopted) sons/daughters of Defence personnel (serving /Retired) of Rajasthan Origin. 50% out of these reserved seats shall be reserved for girls, unfilled seats will be revert back to boys category.
- (f) In case of private medical/ dental colleges, the reservation of seats will be according to the orders of the State government.

Priority order for Defence personnel of Rajasthan origin, with consultation with Director, State Soldier Welfare Board Rajasthan, will be as follows:-

- I Widows/Wards of Defence Personnel killed in action.
- II Wards of those Disabled in action and boarded out from service/died while in service with death attributable to military service / disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service.
- III Widows/Wards of Gallantry Award winners.
- IV Widows/wards of ex-service men.

- (g) Two seats out of the qualified candidates in the RPMT–2010 Examination shall be reserved on merit-cum-priority basis for the natural born (not adopted) sons/daughters of the Para Military personnel (Serving or Retired) of Rajasthan origin.
- (h) 3% seats out of each category of 16% (SC), 12% ST, 21% (OBC) and remaining General Category shall be further reserved on Merit-cum-Priority in each category horizontally for DISABLED candidates having permanent disability as per MCI and Govt. of Rajasthan rules. The Certificate regarding permanent Physical Disability including the percentage, issued by a Medical Board duly constituted by the Central/State government will only be considered. The Under Graduate Admission Board will finally confirm the % of disability by a Medical Board at the time of Interview/counselling.

Note:

Persons with disabilities (Equal opportunities, Protection of Rights and full participation) Act, 1995 and notification No. S.O. 107 (a), dated February 7, 1996 issued from the Ministry of Welfare and published in Gazette of India, Ex.-Ordinary Part. II, Sec. 3(iii) dated 7-02-1996 page 1 by which under clause 2 of Chapter I definitions as (1) Disability means (i) Blindness; (ii) low vision; (iii) Leprosy cured; (iv) hearing impairment; (v) Locomotors disability; (vi) Mental retardation; (vii) Mental illness.

As per Medical Council of India vide No. MCI-34 (1)/ 2003/ Med/ 11773 dated 14-07-2003 and endorsed by Govt. of Rajasthan vide P-5/2 ME/Gr.-I/99 dated 30-07-2003 &P. 6(2) ME/I/2001 dated 18-01-2005 and MCI amended notification No. MCI- 34 (41)/ 2008 med./ 54469 date 25-03-2009:

1. the persons who are visually handicapped and hearing disabled should be deleted from this category and they should not be considered for admission in MBBS courses.
2. only persons with locomotors disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% should be allowed the benefit or reservation under the Disability Act for admission in the medicine courses. This condition shall apply to admission in all medicine courses for reserved seats.

Provided that in case any seat in this 3% quota remains unfilled on account of unavailability of candidates with locomotors disability between 50 to 70% then any such unfilled seat in this 3 % quota shall be filled up by persons with locomotors disability of lower limits between 40 to 50% before they are included in the annual sanctioned seats for General Category candidates.

3. The last valid disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board should not be more than three months old from the date of submitting his/her application for seeking admission in the reserved category for disabled candidates.

- (i) The percentage of girl candidates shall not fall below 25% of the total seats (State) including the girl candidate admitted as per their merit in the general merit but excluding seats reserved under categories a and b.
- (j) The unfilled reserved seat(s) of any category from sub-clauses (a) to (h) shall be filled from the candidates of general category who fulfill conditions laid down in Clause-III.
- (k) **Two medical boards shall be made available by the RUHS at the place of counselling for the medical examination of PH candidates.**

III ELIGIBILITY

No candidate shall be allowed to be admitted to the Medical curriculum of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (M.B.B.S.) Course until: -

1. He/She shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December 2010, i.e., born on or before 01-01-1994.

2. He or she has passed the qualifying examination as under: -

The Senior Secondary examination or the Indian School Certificate Examination, which is equivalent to 10+2 after a period of 12 years study, the last 2 years of study must comprise of Physics, Chemistry, Biology with English as compulsory subject.

Note: Where the Course content is not as prescribed for 10+2 educational structure of the National Committee, the candidate will have to undergo period of one year Pre-Professional training before admission to Medical Colleges. The Pre-Professional Course may be conducted either at a Medical College or a Science College.

Provided also that: -

- i. In case of admission on the basis of competitive entrance examinations, a candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry & Biology at the qualifying examination and in addition must have come in the merit list as a result of such competitive entrance examination by securing not less than 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology taken together in the competitive examination. In respect of candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in qualifying examination and competitive entrance examination be 40% instead of 50% as stated above. Further, for persons with locomotors disability of lower limbs, the minimum of 45% marks for General PH and 40% marks for SC-PH/ST-PH/OBC-PH are required.
- ii. Provided further that a candidate who has appeared in the qualifying examination, the result of which has not been declared is to be provisionally permitted to take up the competitive entrance examination and in case of selection for admission to the MBBS/ BDS Course, he/ she shall not be admitted in that course until he/ she holds the eligibility criteria.
- iii. In the RPMT-2010, there will be two papers. Paper I shall comprise of Section 'A' Physics and Section 'B' Chemistry with 50 questions from physics & 50 questions from chemistry with 150 marks of each subject. Paper II shall comprise of Section 'A' Botany and Section 'B' Zoology with 50 questions of Botany and 50 questions of Zoology with 150 marks of each subject. Each question shall have four options to answer.

3. OTHER ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AS PER CERTIFICATE No. 3 (C) MENTIONED IN FORM "A": -

- I.** The candidate has studied for the last three years of qualifying examination continuously as a regular candidate in a recognised institution in Rajasthan.
- II.** Natural father/Mother of the candidate has continuously resided in Rajasthan for period of last 10 years and the candidate has studied for at least 5 years during this period in a recognised educational institution in Rajasthan.
- III.** All those students who are bonafide residents of Rajasthan but are studying in other states will also be eligible for appearing at Pre- Medical Test.
- IV,V&VI** The candidate is son/ daughter of serving or retired employee of Government of Rajasthan including officers of All India Services borne on State cadres of Rajasthan or Undertaking/Corporation / Improvement Trust/ Municipal Bodies duly constituted by the Government of Rajasthan by an act of Law or any of the University of Rajasthan or Secondary Board of Education (Rajasthan) provided that employee has worked in Rajasthan for three years preceding the last date of submission of the application.
- VII & VIII** Candidate is a son/daughter of a permanent employee of Indian Defence Serving/Retired and the employee is either of Rajasthan origin irrespective of his place of posting or is posted in Rajasthan at the time of last date of the application for admission. Provided that in case of Defence Personnel from Rajasthan origin, a certificate has to be submitted by them from the employer to the effect that his state of origin is Rajasthan at the time of his entry into service. Eligible candidates of this category shall be admitted as per laid down criteria of priority cum merit of the Pre-Medical Test.

- IX & X** Candidate is a son/daughter of serving/Retired person of Para-Military Forces of India and the employee is either of Rajasthan origin, irrespective of his place of posting or is posted in Rajasthan at the time of the last date of the application for admission. Provided that in case of Para-Military personal from the Rajasthan origin, a certificate has to be submitted by them from the employer to the effect that his state of origin is Rajasthan at the time of his entry into service.
- XI** Candidate is a Son/Daughter of a Judge of Rajasthan High Court subject to the condition that he/she submits an undertaking/affidavit stating that such benefit is not being claimed or availed by them in any other State.

IV. SELECTION OF STUDENTS

- i.** The selection of students to a Medical College shall be based solely on the merit of the candidate through a Competitive Entrance Examination except for the candidates belonging to the categories of sub clause a & b of the Clause-II and reservation and priority-cum merit through State Competitive Entrance Examination for the category of the clause - II Reservation.
- ii.** To be eligible for the State Pre-Medical Test, the candidate must have fulfilled the eligibility criteria including the qualifying examination as enumerated under sub- clause- 2 of the clause- III.
- iii.** The eligible passed candidates in the State Pre-Medical test will be admitted in the order of merit for the general as well as reserved seats excepting the seats belonging to the category of the sub-clause 'e' of Clause-II in which case it would be priority- cum- merit.
- iv.** Candidates securing equal marks in the State Pre- Medical Test will be admitted in the following order of preference:
 - (a) One who has secured more marks in the science subjects of 10+2 or its equivalent examination.
 - (b) Among candidates securing equal number of marks in the 10+2 or its equivalent examination, who have passed in lesser number of attempts will be given preference. If, there is a further tie, candidates who have secured more marks in Secondary examination or its equivalent examination will be given preference.

V . INTERVIEW BY ADMISSION BOARD AND ALLOTMENT OF COLLEGE

- i.** The selection will be done by the Undergraduate Admission Board consisting of all the Principals/Representatives of Institutions at **Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Sector-18, Kumbha Marg, Pratap Nagar, Tonk Road, Jaipur – 302 033.**
- ii.** Eligible candidates who have passed the State Pre- Medical Test shall be called for interview/ counselling by the Chairman of the Undergraduate Admission Board to appear before the Board constituted by the State Govt. The presence of the candidate at interview/ counselling is essential. **Authorized representative will not be allowed in any case. The Physically Handicapped candidates will also have to appear in person.** The intimation of the interview/ counselling to candidates shall be notified through Newspapers, University website and Notice Board. No separate intimation will be given.
- iii.** The list of candidates called for interview/ counselling will be put on the Notice Board of the Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur three days before the date of interview. The candidates found unsuitable by the Admission Board will be rejected. The candidates must bring all the original certificates and marks sheets at the time of interview/ counselling.
- iv.** The Undergraduate Admission Board shall interview the candidates and allot them college strictly on the basis of merit- cum- preference. The Presence of candidate at interviews is essential.
- v.** For reasons, to be recorded in writing, if the Admission Board suspects that a particular candidate has obtained certificate by misrepresenting facts, the matter will be referred to the concerned District Magistrate. On receipt of the enquiry report, the Admission Board shall take the final decision regarding the admission of the candidate.
- vi.** A provisional list of the candidates selected by the Admission Board will be put on Notice Board of the Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur. All selected candidates will be examined by the Medical Board, appointed by the Principal of the respective Medical Colleges, at the Medical college allotted to the students on the basis of criteria evolved for the Medical examination by the Principal regarding their general and physical fitness. The candidates found unsuitable will be rejected. The decision of the Medical Board in this respect will be final.

- vii. The Academic session should start within two weeks of allotment of college.
- viii. The last date of submitting vacancy position due to not joining of the allotted candidate within stipulated time to the convener shall be within 4 weeks of allotment of college.
- ix. Re-allotment of vacancies will be done by the Undergraduate Admission Board on interview of the candidates within 14 days of the last date of submitting the vacancy position.
- x. The candidate is entitled for re-allotment / reshuffling only if he/she joins and continues the allotted courses and college, failing which his/her selection will be terminated.
- xi. The vacancies due to not joining of the candidates within the stipulated time shall be filled by re-allotment by the Undergraduate Admission Board on the basis of merit cum preference from the candidates who have already joined the allotted course and colleges and the resultant vacancies or such vacancies, which could not be filled by reallotment, shall be filled by taking the candidates from the waiting list on merit cum preference at the time of interview. The candidates can also give their names for waiting list for any vacancies to be created in future. Last date of admission shall be September 30, 2010 as per Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment dated 11-09-2002. No admission can be given after 30 September 2010 even if any vacancies occur subsequently.
- xii. Admission fee shall have to be deposited at the time of counselling and allotment of seat. Detail of admission fee will be intimated on website of RUHS before counselling. For private medical and dental college one week time will be given for submitting requisite bank guarantee. If candidate do not deposit the amount of bank guarantee into the college within a week then the seat will be allotted to next candidate and 25% of admission fees will be forfeited and remaining amount will be returned to the candidate.

SLP 1491/2000(2002)-MCI बनाम मधुसिंह केस में माननीय सर्वोच्च न्यायालय द्वारा पारित निर्णय दिनांक 11.09.2002 की अनुपालना में भारत सरकार/MCI द्वारा घोषित कलेण्डर के अनुसार 30 सितम्बर तक ही प्रवेश दिये जा सकते हैं। इसके बाद प्रवेश नहीं दिये जायेंगे। राज्य सरकार के पत्र क्रमांक प.9 (4) एम.ई./गुप-1/2005 दिनांक 09.02.2005 एवं माननीय उच्चतम न्यायालय द्वारा मृदुल धर व अन्य बनाम भारत सरकार व अन्य नामक याचिका संख्या 306/2004 में हुये निर्णय दिनांक 12.01.2005 में दिये गये दिशा-निर्देशों के अनुसार प्रवेश परीक्षा प्रवेश प्रक्रिया एवं प्रवेश निर्धारित कैलेण्डर के अनुसार होगी तथा 30.09.2010 के पश्चात् किसी भी अवस्था में प्रवेश नहीं दिये जायेंगे, भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद् नई दिल्ली के पत्रांक एम सी आई 7(10) 2005-लीगल/15118 दिनांक 21.11.2005 के अनुसार प्रवेश की कार्यवाही की जावेगी।

RPMT-2010 परीक्षा या प्रवेश या दोनों सम्बन्धी नियमों में परिवर्तन भी किया जा सकता है। परीक्षा के पश्चात नियमानुसार वरीयता सूची की घोषणा की जायेगी। परीक्षा परिणाम नोटिस बोर्ड पर लगाया जायेगा। इसे ही अधिकृत परीक्षा परिणाम माना जायेगा। समाचार पत्रों में प्रकाशित परिणाम अधिकृत नहीं माना जायेगा। परिणाम में किसी प्रकार की त्रुटि का संशोधन किया जायेगा। General Guidelines (Syllabus and Information Booklet) ध्यानपूर्वक पढ़ें। नियमों में परिवर्तन भी किये जा सकते हैं जो परीक्षार्थी को अनिवार्य रूप से मान्य होंगे।

The apex court drew guidelines for the management of all educational institutions to follow. Among them:

Educational institutions should take anti-ragging measures right from the time of advertisement for admissions. The prospectus, the form for admission and/or any other literature issued to aspirants for admission must clearly mention that ragging is banned in the institution and anyone indulging in it is likely to be punished appropriately which may include expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology.

The punishment may also take the shape of: (i) withholding scholarships or other benefits (ii) debarring from representation in events (iii) withholding results (iv) suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess. If there be any legislation governing ragging or any provisions in statute/ordinance, it should be brought to the notice of the students/parents seeking admissions. A printed leaflet detailing when and to whom a victim may turn for information, help and guidance for various purposes, keeping in view the needs of new entrants, along with their addresses and telephone numbers should be given to fresher at the time of admissions so that they need not to look to seniors for help in such matters.

**GENERAL RULES FOR ADMISSION TO B.V.Sc. & A.H. DEGREE COURSE
(FIVE YEARS' DURATION)
AT THE COLLEGE OF VETERINARY AND ANIMAL SCIENCE, BIKANER
(A CONSTITUENT COLLEGE) AND
VETERINARY COLLEGES AFFILIATED WITH
SWAMI KESHWANAND RAJASTHAN AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY, BIKANER**

[**Note:** Admissions to the College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Navania, Vallabhnagar, Udaipur (a Constituent College of MPUAT, Udaipur) shall also be done by the same admission board following the eligibility criteria mentioned hereunder. However, the difference in other rules, if any, shall be informed by the representative of the respective College/MPUAT, Udaipur at the time of counselling, which shall be binding on the students seeking admission there.]

1. Number of seats:

A. College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner:

- a. **Regular seats-** 60 (Sixty)
- b. **Payment seats-** 15 (Fifteen)

B. Affiliated Veterinary Colleges:

At present the following Veterinary Colleges are affiliated with Swami Keshwanand Rajasthan Agricultural University, Bikaner:

- (a) Arawali Veterinary College, Jaipur Road, Sikar;
- (b) B.S. College of Veterinary Medicine & Research Centre, Ghoriwara Kalan, Mukundgarh, Jhunjhunu;
- (c) Mahatma Gandhi Veterinary College, Agra Road, Bharatpur;
- (d) Mahatma Jyotiba Phule College of Veterinary & Animal Science, Chomu, Jaipur; and
- (e) Sri Ganganagar Veterinary College, Near RIICO colony, Sri Ganganagar.

In each Affiliated College, 30 seats are regular seats and 30 seats are management seats. The fees structure shall be notified and announced by the respective affiliated college at the time of counselling.

2. Admissions & Reservations:

A. Admissions on the basis of RPMT-2010 to B.V.Sc. & A.H. Course programme for the academic session 2010-11, in constituent as well as affiliated Veterinary Colleges will be done by Central U.G. Admission Board following admission process, which may extend to more than one round of counselling, on merit-cum-reservation basis from the successful and eligible candidates of RPMT-2010 maintaining the reservations as prescribed by State Government of Rajasthan, shall include the **following type of seats:**

- i. **Remaining Regular State Seats** out of 60 Regular seats in the College of Veterinary & Animal Science, Bikaner [as fifteen per cent seats are reserved to be filled on All India basis through AIPVT-2010 to be conducted by the Veterinary Council of India, New Delhi under clause (8) of Minimum Standards of Veterinary Education (Degree Course- B.V.Sc. & A.H) Regulations, 2008];
- ii. **Fifteen payment seats** of College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner; and
- iii. **Regular seats of affiliated Veterinary Colleges** (30 seats in each college).

B. In the event of affiliation/ disaffiliation of any Veterinary College (s) the name (s) of such Veterinary College (s) and number of seats in them will be notified before/at the time of counselling.

C. As per the Veterinary Council of India -Minimum Standards of Veterinary Education-Degree Course (B.V.Sc. & A.H.) Regulations, 2008 [PART III -7. (9)], a candidate shall not be allowed admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. Degree course if he/she suffers **disabilities in physical fitness** as listed below:

- (a) disability of total body including disability of chest/spine more than 50 per cent.
- (b) disability of lower limb of more than 50 per cent.
- (c) disability of upper limb.

- (d) visually handicapped candidates and those with hearing disability.
- (e) candidates with progressive diseases like myopathies etc.
- (f) disabilities which otherwise would interfere in the performance of the duties of a veterinarian.

Furthermore, as per above regulation of the VCI [PART III -7. (10)], the disability should be certified by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board comprising of at least three specialists out of which two should be of the specialty concerned and the candidate has to present him/her- self before the Medical Board. The last valid disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board should not be more than three months old from the date of submitting his/her certificate for disabled candidates.

D. Professional Fees of payment seat, will be on the basis of per professional programme over and above the regular fees of college / Hostel/ any other Head. If any student fails in any of the professional programme(s) during the course of study, he/she would have to pay the same additional amount of Professional Fees per professional programme(s) over and above the regular fees of college / Hostel/ any other Head for repeating the programme(s) in which he/she has failed. Professional Fees per professional programme shall be the amount as declared and notified by the University. Currently it is Rs. 1,00,000/- per professional programme of five year study in the B.V.Sc. & A.H. Course programme. The professional fees once paid is non-refundable, even if the candidate admitted under payment seat category opts to leave the college for reasons whatsoever, except reshuffling during the process of counselling.

E. After completion of counselling and admission process by the Central U.G. Admission Board (after which the admissions to the B.V.Sc. & A.H. course programme will deemed as closed for the session), candidates admitted on payment seat shall not be considered for admission on any unfilled /vacant seat of any of the category under regular state seats.

F. In case of candidates securing equal marks (tie) in the RPMT-2010 merit, the tie shall be broken to determine merit amongst themselves, as per the procedure given below, in the same serial order:

- (i) One who has secured more marks in Science Biology group subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) at the Senior Secondary (10 + 2) examination or its equivalent recognized examination.
- (a) Among the candidates securing equal number of marks in the Science Biology group subjects at the Senior Secondary (10 + 2) examination or its equivalent recognized examination, preference in order will be given to the candidate who has passed this qualifying examination in lesser number of attempts.
- (b) If there is further tie, preference in order will be given to the candidate who has secured more marks in Secondary school examination or its equivalent recognized examination.

3. The candidates must fulfill the eligibility criteria for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. course programme as prescribed by the Veterinary Council of India -Minimum Standards of Veterinary Education-Degree Course (B.V.Sc. & A.H.) Regulations, 2008 [PART III].

Salient provisions are explained as follows:

a. Age: The candidate must have completed the age of 17 years on or before 31st December-2010. Candidates attaining seventeen years on 1st of January 2011 or later will not be eligible.

b. Educational qualifications:

The candidate must have passed the Senior Secondary examination (Science Biology group) conducted by a Statutory Board under 10+2 pattern of the Secondary Education or any other examination recognized equivalent to it individually in all the compulsory subjects including English and optional subjects of Science Biology Group (Physics, Chemistry and Biology);

Or

The candidate who is taking up the qualifying examination in the year 2009-10 and whose result has not been declared by the last date of submission of application form may also apply and take up the said test but he/ she shall not be eligible for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. course programme if he/ she does not fulfill the required eligibility;

Provided further, that he/she must have obtained a minimum of 50 per cent marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English at the above mentioned qualifying examination, with a relaxation of up to 40 per cent instead of 50 per cent in case of SC/ST and OBC categories. Further, for physically handicapped candidates of general unreserved category this percentage will be 45 per cent.

c. Other Eligibility Criteria:

The candidate has studied for the last three years of qualifying examination continuously as a regular candidate in a recognized institution in Rajasthan.

or

Natural Father /Mother of the candidate who has continuously resided in Rajasthan for a period of at least 10 years and candidate has studied for at least 5 years during this period in a recognized educational institution in Rajasthan.

or

The candidates who is bonafide resident of Rajasthan but are studying in other states.

or

The candidate is the Son/ Daughter of serving or retired employee of- Government of Rajasthan including officer of All India Services on the State Cadre of Rajasthan; or Undertaking/ Corporation/ Urban Improvement Trust/ Municipal Bodies duly constituted by the Government of Rajasthan by the act of Law; or any of the Universities established under the act in Rajasthan or Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan provided that the employee has worked in the Rajasthan for three years preceding the last date of submission of the application form of RPMT-2010.

or

The candidate is the Son/ Daughter of a permanent employee of Defence Service and the employee is either of Rajasthan origin irrespective of his place of posting or is posted in Rajasthan at the time of last date of the application form for admission provided that in case Defence Personnel from the Rajasthan origin, a Certificate has to be submitted by him from the employer to the effect that his state of origin is Rajasthan at the time of entry into the service.

or

The candidate is the Son/ Daughter of a Judge of Rajasthan High Court subject to that he/she submits an undertaking/affidavit stating that such benefit is not claimed or availed by them in any other state.

or

Candidate is a Son/Daughter of serving/Retired person of Para Military Forces of India and the employee is either of Rajasthan origin irrespective of his place of posting or is posted in Rajasthan on the last date of the application for admission Provided that in case of Para Military Personnel from the Rajasthan origin, a certificate has to be submitted by them from the employer to the effect that his state of origin in Rajasthan at the time of his entry into service.

- 4. Counselling:** Candidates eligible for admission on the basis of merit of RPMT- 2010 in their respective categories shall be called for counselling by the Central UG Admission Board, constituted by the Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. programme. The candidate found unsuitable by the Central UG Admission Board will be rejected.
- 5. Verification of documents:** The candidates must bring compulsorily following original documents for verification on the day of counselling as well as on the day of reporting for admission formalities in the respective Veterinary College along with their two sets of attested photocopies and any other documents, if mentioned in counselling notification:
- i. Four recent color photographs (as pasted in RPMT-2010 Application form) with name and date of taking photograph
 - ii. Admit card of RPMT-2010
 - iii. Marks sheet of RPMT-2010
 - iv. Mark sheet of Senior Secondary Examination
 - v. Mark sheet and Certificate of Secondary Examination (For proof of age)
 - vi. Character certificate issued from the last attended college/school
 - vii. Domicile certificate of Rajasthan
 - viii. Cast certificate
 - ix. The candidate claiming admission under physically handicapped category must bring compulsorily the certificate showing his/her physical disability as provided in 2. C above.
 - x. Any other document required proving the eligibility for admission.

Note:

1. The relevant certificates required deciding eligibility will have to be furnished by the candidate.
 2. The residence certificate wherever required will have to be duly signed by the competent authority with the official seal.
 3. In case of serving personnel where service conditions have resulted into eligibility, a certificate of employer will have to be submitted by the candidate.
 4. Any person other than the parents of the candidate can become guardian, only if the parents of the candidate are not alive or have been declared insane.
-
7. Admission of candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from the University / Board of the state other than Rajasthan will be provisional till the Eligibility certificate is issued by the Rajasthan Agricultural University, Bikaner after fulfilling the necessary requirement by the candidate.
 8. If for the reasons, to be recorded in the writing, the Admission board suspects that a particular candidate had obtained a certificate by misrepresenting the facts or any document being fake/alterd, the matter shall be dealt with as a criminal offence. The decision of the UG Admission Board pertaining to any matter/dispute in the counselling/ admissions shall be final and binding.
 9. All the candidates provisionally admitted B.V.Sc. & A.H. course programme by the Central Undergraduate Admission Board would have to undergo Medical checkup for physical fitness. The admission of candidate found unsuitable in this medical examination will be cancelled.
 10. After declaration of closure of admission no admission will be given even if any seat remains/ falls vacant due to reason whatsoever (including admission withdrawal/dropping by the admitted candidates from the course programme/cancellation of admission/ absence/ unavailability of candidate under any category of students or type of seats-regular or payment etc.)
 11. The fee (except caution money) of any kind (professional as well as regular) and other charges including hostel rent etc. once paid (excluding only the cases of shifting of admission from one college/faculty to another during the course of different rounds of counselling of RPMT-2010) shall not be refunded even if a student leaves the institute for any reason. No correspondence in this matter shall be entertained.
 12. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, interpretation of competent authority with respect to any rule as has been actually prescribed by the University shall be final and binding. Changes/ Amendments in rule(s) mentioned above can be done at any time by the competent authority even after the declaration of the result of RPMT-2010 or at the time of admission to the B.V.Sc. & A.H. course programme. The candidates will have to abide compulsorily with such changes.

GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATES APPEARING AT THE COUNSELLING FOR ADMISSION TO B.V. Sc. & A.H. PROGRAMME

All the successful and eligible candidates of RPMT-2010 examination desirous of seeking admission in B.V.Sc & A.H. course programme running at the College of Veterinary and Animal Science, R.A.U., Bikaner and affiliated colleges shall be called through advertisement in state's leading newspaper. They shall be asked to appear personally for counselling before the Undergraduate Admission Board along with all the original documents RPMT-2010 examination admission card and mark sheet, Transcript and certificate of Secondary examination, Transcript of 10+2 examination, Domicile Certificate issued by the competent authority, Character Certificate issued by last attended School/College, Medical fitness certificate issued by the Medical Jurist of any Government Medical college of Rajasthan and four identical recent colour photos at the place of counselling of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner as per the Category-wise, dates and time schedule to be announced through news paper. In case if the original documents of the candidate have been deposited in any other college, he/she will have to necessarily furnish a certificate in this regard from the concerned Head of college, other wise he/she will not be considered for admission.

In addition, the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC categories must also bring respective certificate of category issued from the competent authority only) and two sets of duly attested photocopies of above mentioned original documents

1. The admission board reserves the right to re-schedule the counselling of the day to the following day or any subsequent day(s) as per the requirement of situation.
2. Candidates should note it carefully that no separate call letters shall be sent to them. The candidates will be asked to appear at counselling on the basis of the published notification, as per category-wise scheduled date and time, positively. If any candidate remains absent from counselling on scheduled date and time as per this notification, it shall be presumed that he/she is not interested in seeking admission in this course and thus he/she will automatically forfeit his/her right of admission and shall not be considered for admission after the due date and time of counselling. His/ her seat will be filled by the candidate of next lower merit who is present at the time of counselling. He/she, in this way, will also forfeit the right to be considered for subsequent counselling, if any, done by calling candidates lower in merit.
3. The presence of the candidate at the time of counselling is essential. No representative on his or her behalf will be considered to appear in the counselling.
4. In case of admission under 51 state seats at College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner, the candidates will be required to deposit their fees immediately at the time of counselling. For this, the candidates should bring Rs. 3000/- (Rupees Three thousand only) in cash with them. In case of failure to deposit fees at the time of counselling, the admission will be automatically cancelled. Except college caution money amount, all other fees, once deposited, are non-refundable.
5. The admission under 15 payment seats at College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner will be made on merit-cum-reservation policy basis out of the successful candidates of RPMT-2010 present at the time of counselling after filling the 51 state seats. The candidate selected under these payment seats will have to pay first professional fees amount (non-refundable) of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) at the time of counselling in the form of demand draft only in favour of Dean, College of Veterinary and Animal Science, payable at Bikaner failing which he/she shall not be considered for admission on payment seats at all. In addition to this professional fees amount, he/she will also have to pay the regular fees amount in cash (approximately Rs. 3000/-) at the time of admission. The professional fees amount (non-refundable) @ Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) per professional programme for the remaining professional programmes (i.e. 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th as well as failure(s) professional programmes) will be payable at the time of registration of each professional programme during the course of study in addition to the regular fee. However, if a candidate fails in any annual professional programme(s) during the course of study, he will have to deposit this professional fee amount again for that particular professional programme(s) in addition to the regular fees. The professional fees amount for payment seat, once deposited, is non refundable. The candidates should note it carefully. The status of candidate selected under 15 payment seats of College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner will not be changed even if any seat subsequently falls vacant in state seats quota under any category.

6. The candidates claiming admission under 3 per cent seats reserved for Physically handicapped/ disabled category must bring compulsorily the certificate regarding his/her permanent physical disability indicating the percentage disability, issued by Medical Board duly constituted by State Government only, which should not be more than three months old. Certificate issued by authority other than such Medical Board will not be considered. If required, the candidates belonging to Physically handicapped/ disabled category may be asked to appear before the fresh medical board at the time of counselling so as to decide the nature and extent of their physical disability. The admission eligibility criteria with respect to physical disability in case of physically handicapped/disabled candidates will be the same as prescribed for recruitment of Veterinary Graduates on certain designated posts by the State Govt. of Rajasthan. There shall be no sub-reservation for boys and girls separately out of 3 per cent seats reserved for candidates of physically handicapped/disabled category. The physically handicapped category candidates provided admission on their merit shall occupy the seat of respective category (General/OBC/SC/ST-Boys and Girls) to which they belong and consequently the number of seats available to non- physically handicapped/disabled candidates in that category shall stand reduced by equivalent numbers.
7. The candidates will be considered for counselling only up till the availability of vacant seat at their merit position of concerned category. Once all the seats under any particular category are completely filled the counselling for that category will be immediately stopped. Merely calling for counselling as per this notification does not guarantee the candidates for the right of admission.
8. The admissions shall be treated as provisional subject to the final decision of any pending case(s) in any court of law, if applicable to these admissions. Further, the provisional status of admission shall stand cleared only after enrolment by the university.
9. No TA & DA would be paid to candidates called for counselling / admission.
10. The Rajasthan Agricultural University, Bikaner reserves the right to change/amend any rule /fees structure (payment seat fee /regular fee) etc. at any time during the course of study.
11. Candidates appearing for counselling should also see carefully the instructions for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree courses printed in information booklet (RPMT-2010). All the judgments relevant to these admissions, passed by any Hon'ble court of justice as well as rules existing at the time of counselling will be applicable on these admissions and the candidates will have to abide compulsorily with such judgments, rules and the changes.
12. After filling all the regular and payment seats of College of Veterinary & Animal Science, Bikaner the admissions for the session for this college shall be closed and further no admission will be given to any candidate of any category even if any seat falls vacant thereafter.
