Last date for submission of duly filled application form along with prescribed fee and documents is 5.00 p.m. of 12.07.2010. No Application forms will be accepted after due date and time. RUHS will not take any responsibility for any postal delay. The incomplete form in any respect may be rejected summarily.

CANDIDATES CAN APPEAR IN MAXIMUM TWO SUBJECTS AS PER THEIR ELIGIBILITY FOR PRE D.M./M.CH. EXAMINATION. A CANDIDATE HAS TO FILL SEPARATE FORM FOR EACH SUBJECT AND MUST ENCLOSE D.D. OF Rs. 3000/- (Three thousand) PER SUBJECT).

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES APPEARING AT
PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010**

SECTION A: INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING FOR PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010

1. The candidate should send the duly filled Application Form (available at RUHS website; www.ruhsraj.org) along with a demand draft of Rs. 3,000/- (for one subject) (in favour of Registrar, Rajasthan University of Health Sciences payable at Jaipur) with attested copies of the required documents, two recent photographs and three self addressed envelopes 30 X 22 cm (without postal stamps) to the Convener, PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010, Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Sector-18, Kumbha Marg, Pratap Nagar, Tonk Road, Jaipur – 302 033 (Raj.)
2. The form should be printed on A4 size paper and sent (in A4 size envelope) either by Registered Post/ Speed Post well in advance or it may be submitted in person in the office of the Convener, PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010 so as to reach the office latest by 5.00 p.m. of 12.07.2010. Application Forms reaching after this time and date shall not be entertained/ accepted. **Any excuse or delay in sending the Application Form or any postal delay later than this date & time limit shall not be entertained**
3. The Convener shall not be responsible for any application form handed over at any place other than designated place for deposition of PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010 application form.
4. The candidate must paste his/her coloured photograph in the Application Form taken after 01.04.2010 with date and name on the photograph.
5. The candidate must ensure his/her eligibility before filling the application form. The criteria for eligibility are given in this instruction booklet.
6. Candidates can appear in **Pre D.M./M.Ch. examination** for maximum **two subjects** if they fulfill the eligibility of other subject. Such Candidates have to fill separate form for each subject along with fee of Rs. 3,000/- per subject through DD as mentioned above.
7. For candidates applying for more than one subject, examination may fall in two shifts on same day. Candidates should be ready for two subject examinations in one day in shifts.
8. The form shall be treated incomplete, if-
 - a. Photograph is not pasted on the application form and signed by appropriate authority
 - b. Any required column is left un-filled in the Application Form.
 - c. Any part of the Application Form has been cut/removed or not enclosed, such application forms are liable to be rejected.
 - d. Required attested documents are not enclosed
9. The application form fee once deposited is neither refundable, nor transferable and nor adjustable for future **PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATIONS**. Any plea in this matter shall not be entertained.
10. The jurisdiction for legal cases arising out of PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010 shall be limited to the competent courts at Jaipur only.
11. Candidate is required to enclose the following while submitting the application:
 1. Duly filled Application Form
 2. Duly filled admit card
 3. Attested copies of
 - a. Degree/provisional certificate, all marks sheets of undergraduate examination
 - b. Degree/provisional certificate, all marks sheets of postgraduate examination
 - c. Date of Birth Certificate preferably 10th Certificate or any other equivalent certificate
 - d. Certificate of In-service from DMHS/Principal of concerned Institution
 - e. Any other relevant certificate(s)
 4. Three self addressed envelopes (11 x 25 cm)
 5. Two recent coloured photographs (enclosed separately in small envelop)
 6. Demand Draft for the requisite amount

SECTION B: ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

Candidates from all over India are allowed to appear in Pre D.M./M.Ch. examination for D.M./M.Ch. courses for year-2010. The candidates should fulfill the eligibility criteria for admission to above courses as under:-

1- Educational Qualification

The candidate seeking admission to D.M./M.Ch. course must possess MD/MS degree from this University or recognized degree from any other institution in the subjects as under:

Candidates already appeared in MD/MS Post Graduate degree program of their eligibility and whose result is awaited may also apply for **PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010**. Such a candidate shall be permitted provisionally to appear in said examination. However, Candidate must qualify the PG degree program and has to submit marks statement/provisional certificate of University before or latest by the time of interview.

Important to note: If at any stage it is found that a non-eligible candidate is trying to get admission in a course then the admission of such a candidate will be cancelled on such detection. A legal action shall be initiated against such candidate.

2- Number of seats

The tentative number of available seats in each subject is given below. The number of seats may increase or decrease; the exact number of seats shall be notified on RUHS website before interview.

3- Reservation and Bond for In-service Candidates

Out of Total seats 30 % are reserved for In-Service candidates of Rajasthan State Government. (Subject to approval by competent body of RUHS) .

In-service eligible candidates of Rajasthan Medical Service [Collegiate branch] or Rajasthan State Medical and Health Services have to execute bond of 20 lacs and same have to furnish on selection.

SECTION C: INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE EXAMINATION

1. The PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010 shall be held at Jaipur. Examination centre shall be notified on RUHS website. All candidates are required to appear in PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010 at their own expenses. No TA/DA will be paid for the purpose.
2. The examination shall be held as per program given below:

a- Examination scheme

The Competitive **PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010** will be held at Jaipur on 22nd July, 2010.. Venue/Center shall be notified on RUHS website: www.ruhsraj.org

b- Examination Pattern

(For selection in D.M./M.Ch Courses-2010, candidates are required to appear in all three parts of examination for final selection.

Part- A (Theory)

Examination consists of 80 (eighty) multiple-choice questions carrying one mark each. The total Maximum Marks shall be 80. The duration of examination shall be 90 minutes from the distribution of question paper.

The multiple -choice questions will be from applied basic sciences and general subjects of Medicine for DM and Surgery for M.Ch. directly or indirectly in reference with the concerned super-specialties of the standard of MD/MS Examination.

Note: There will be negative marking for wrong answers. One fourth marks will be deducted for each wrong or multiple answered question. No marks shall be awarded/deducted for any unattempted question.

Separate Merit list shall be prepared for each subject on the basis of marks obtained by candidates.

Part- B (Clinical/Practical)

The candidates will be invited for the clinical/practical examination strictly in order of merit in the respective super specialty, up to FIVE TIMES of the number of seats to be filled in each subject.

Clinical/Practical Examination (carries 20 marks) shall be conducted by the concerned department. In clinical/practical examination the general cases of the concerned super-specialty will be kept along with X-rays instruments and pathology specimens. Three senior members of the concerned department under the governorship of Head of department will conduct it.

Date time and venue of clinical/practical test shall be notified on RUHS website.

The minimum passing marks in selection test (Theory + Clinical/Practical examination) to qualify for admission in D.M. /M.Ch. courses are 50 (Fifty).

Part- C (Interview)

Candidate has to appear before selection committee comprising of Principal & Head of the Department of the concerned super specialty for the purpose, which will recommend name of those found suitable for admission. (For detailed Admission procedure refer Section-D of this booklet)

c- Instructions for appearing in examination:

- 1- Mere appearing in the **PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010** will not confer any right upon the candidate to be admitted to D.M./M.Ch.
- 2- Admit card shall be sent to all eligible candidates by post or any other appropriate means. However due to any postal loss/delay, candidate does not receive their admit card till 20th July, 2010 may visit RUHS website for details and contact RUHS Entrance Cell for issue of duplicate admit card on 21st July, 2010 between 11 AM to 2.00 PM. in person or at the examination centre before one hour of the commencement of the examination i.e. on 22nd July, 2010. Such candidates must bring the photo Id proof and its copy for identity along with spare copy of same photo pasted in application form.
- 3- The candidates are expected to take their seats 15 minutes before commencement of the examination. No candidate coming after 15 minutes of the commencement of the examination shall be permitted to appear in the examination.
- 4- Candidate will be required to produce admit card before he/she is allowed to enter the examination centre.
- 5- Candidate must bring two blue/black ballpoint pens.
- 6- No candidate shall be allowed to carry any text material written or printed, bits of paper or any other material except the admit card inside the examination room/hall. Cellular/Mobile phone / Pager / Calculator etc. will not be permitted in the examination room/hall.
- 7- The candidate shall maintain silence during the examination. Any disturbance created by the candidate during examination will be deemed misbehavior and the candidate involved in such activity shall forfeit his/her right to continue in the examination. The decision of the Centre Superintendent shall be final and conclusive in the matter.
- 8- No candidate shall be allowed to go outside the examination room/hall till the completion of the examination.
- 9- Writing anything on the admit card or any stray paper will be treated as unfair means. Candidate should not temper with the question booklet or tear any page out of it.
- 10- Candidates should read the instructions carefully given in the question paper booklet. They shall abide by the instructions issued during the examination, by the Invigilators or the Center Superintendent.
- 11- The candidate is forbidden to write his/her name or to make such signs as may disclose his/her identity on any part of the answer sheet. Non-compliance of this rule shall be reported to the Convener, **PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010** and shall be punishable as per rules, for adopting unfair means.
- 12- No Candidate shall leave or allowed to leave the examination room until question paper booklet and answer sheet even though these may be unused handed over to invigilator. He will not leave the room without taking permission from invigilator.
- 13- No part of the question booklet should be removed from it. At the end of each examination, the question booklet and the answer sheet must be handed over to the Invigilator before leaving the examination room.

d- Unfair means

Warning: The candidates are warned that with the promulgation of Rajasthan Public Examination (Prevention of Unfair Means) Act, 1992 by the Government of Rajasthan vide Extraordinary Gazette Notification dated 11th November 1992, the use of unfair means at a public examination is an offence under the law and accordingly the person(s) found guilty of resorting to or using unfair means at the **PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010** can be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend up to 3 years or with fine which may extend up to Rupees Two Thousand or with both.

The following acts shall be considered as unfair means:

- Possession of any objectionable material.
- Tearing of the Question Paper Booklet or any part thereof including answer sheets.
- Any attempt by candidate to obtain any information about question(s) set in any examination paper or communication with any candidate in the examination hall.
- Communication by the candidate with any person concerned with the examination work with the intention of influencing him/her for the award of marks.
- Communication by the candidate with any person with the intention of obtaining information about the marks secured before declaration of the **PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010** result.
- Any activity by the candidate, which in the opinion of the Invigilator is likely to give unfair advantage to him/her.
- Refusal/Resistance by the candidate for search to find out whether he/she possesses any objectionable material.
- Taking away the Question Paper Booklet and/or Main Copy of the answer sheet outside the examination hall.

If a complaint is lodged against a candidate that he/she used or attempted to use unfair means in the examination, the matter shall be placed before the Unfair Means Committee to be appointed by the Convener, **PRE D.M./M.Ch EXAMINATION-2010** for recommendation and accordingly the matter will be decided.

e- Court Orders:

If a candidate is declared in-eligible for examination in that case any competent courts passes any order in favour of candidate to appear in the above examination shall be allowed only on submission of certified copy of court order before examination.

SECTION D: ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Selection of Candidate for D.M./M.Ch. course will be made as per Ordinance 278(D) by following the procedure given in the instruction booklet.

Based on the aggregate marks obtained by the candidates in Theory Paper, Clinical/Practical Viva-Voce Examination, merit list will be prepared subject wise separately of candidates. The candidates will then be interviewed by the Selection Committee comprising of Principal & Head of the Department of the concerned super specialty (Higher specialty) for the purpose, which will recommend the name of those found suitable for admission.

The selection shall be finalized only after candidates are interviewed by the selection committee. The interview by the selection committee is mandatory. **A candidate who is absent at the time of interview will not be considered for admission.** The interview with the selection committee does not carry any marks. However, the minimum marks in the selection test required for all candidates to qualify for admission are 50 (Fifty).

Note: In case of any other mode of admission, separate instructions / guidelines will be provided to the candidates through newspapers / website etc.

Inter-se merit

If two or more candidates obtain equal marks in the entrance examination, then their inter-se merit for selection shall be determined on the basis of the following:

- (a) A candidate, who has made more attempts in passing the MD/MS Examination, shall rank below the candidate who has taken less attempts.
- (b) If the attempts made in passing the MD/MS Examination are also equal than a candidate who has made more attempts in passing various professional M.B.B.S. examination shall rank junior to a candidate who has made less attempts.
- (c) If attempts in passing MD/MS Examination as also in the M.B.B.S. professional examination are also the same then a candidate who has obtained higher marks in the final M.B.B.S. examination shall rank senior to candidate who has obtained less marks.
- (d) If the attempts made in passing MD/MS and M.B.B.S. professional examination as also the marks obtained in M.B.B.S./final examination are the same, then a candidate senior in age rank senior to the candidate who is junior in age.

Period of Joining

After declaration of final selection list candidates are required to join their D.M./M.Ch latest by 31st July, 2010 failing which their selection will be cancelled automatically.

Period of Training

The period of training for obtaining D.M./M.Ch. degree shall be three completed years (including the examination period) after obtaining MD/MS degree, or equivalent recognized qualifications in the required subject. Migration/Transfer of Postgraduate students from one Medical College or Institution to another: Migration/transfer of students undergoing any postgraduate course degree/diploma shall not be permitted by University or any authority.

The University reserves the right to reject any application for proper reasons adduced therewith.

The admissions shall be treated as provisional subject to the final decision of any pending case(s) in any court of law, if applicable to these admissions. Further, the provisional status of admission shall stand cleared only after enrolment by the university.

All the judgments relevant to these admissions, passed by any Hon'ble court of justice as well as rules existing at the time of making admissions will be applicable on these admissions and the candidates will have to abide compulsorily with such judgments, rules and the changes.

In case of any legal dispute, the jurisdiction shall be limited to the competent courts at Jaipur only.
